from Abbeville to the Ondefontaine and Guiberville areas, 13-23 Jul; assignment in Normandy, 24 Jul-20 Aug; defensive operations in the Bieville and Le Beny-Bocage areas, 24-29 Jul, and the Caumont area, 30 Jul-4 Aug; defensive operations and counterattacks in the Saint-Jean-le-Blanc area, 5-14 Aug; encirclement, 17-20 Aug; and the breakthrough of the encirclement at Saint-Lambert by remnants of the 326.ID, 21 Aug 1944. Daily intelligence reports, intelligence bulletins with maps, and interrogation summaries.

Ic, TB. Activity report concerning transfer from Eitorf, Germany, to Fuezesabony, Hungary, 18-27 Sep 1944; movement to Galanta, Slovakia, 2-11 Oct; transfer from Galanta to Gerolstein, Germany, 20-26 Nov; and movement to the Nohn, Gemuend, and Schleiden areas, 2-10 Dec 1944.
