A unit history, with maps, of the 349.ID, previously "Kampfgruppe Kanalkueste," concerning its activation from remnants of the 217.ID, parts of the recently activated 376. and 384.ID, and Turkestani volunteers in the Saint-Omer, Aire, and Lumbres areas of France, 25 Nov 1943; training in the Saint-Cmer area, Nov 1943-Feb 1944; and construction of coastal and rear area positions in the Calais and Boulogne areas, Feb-Mar 1944.

Transfer to Lvov (Lemberg), Ukrainian S.S.R., and assembly in the Zolochev (Zloczow) area, 26-31 Mar; closing of the frontline gap in the Brody and Ternopol areas, 1-15 Apr; position defense in the Perepelich'ye area, 15 Apr-13 Jul; encirclement during the large-scale Russian offensive and breakthrough in the Sasov and Zolochev areas, 14-20 Jul; withdrawal to Korczyn for rest and rehabilitation, via Przemyslany, Chodorov, and Stry, 21-31 Jul; withdrawal to Skole and Tuchla and assembly in Mukachevo, 1-20 Aug; and disbandment, 10 Aug 1944.

Includes a division order for assembly in the Zolochev area, 26-31 Mar 1944; and a report on the operation against the fortifications system south of Trostyanets (Troszianiec-Wielk), 23 May 1944. (The document indicates that only the Div.Stab and the Abwicklungsstab were available for the activation of the 349. Volksgrenadier-Division in Sep 1944.)
