Records of the 454.SichD are reproduced on rolls 2215-2221 of NARS Microfilm Publication T315 and are described following the unit history.

Although no records of this division dated later than 1943/06/30 were available in the National Archives, the Order of Battle of the German Army (Washington, Mar 1945) states that the division was engaged in the southern sector of the eastern front during the Soviet summer offensive, until Jul 1944, and the Potsdam catalog gives the division's disbandment on 13 Aug 1944.
