## 22. Infanterie-Division (22d Infantry Division)

The 22. Infanterie-Division was activated in Bremen, Wehrkreis X, on August 16, 1939. It fought in Holland in May 1940 as an airborne division, participated in the victory parade in Paris, and then was transferred to Antwerp for occupation duties. The division transferred to Rumania in May 1941 and took part in the June invasion of Russia in the southern sector, advancing to the Crimea. In July and August 1942 it was transferred to Salonika, Greece, and in September and October of the same year, to Crete. (At that time, the subordinated Grenadier-Regiment 47 was detached and

transferred to Tripoli, Libya, and was eventually destroyed in Tunisia). In the spring of 1943 the division was reorganized as a motorized division although it was never officially designated as such. Part of the division, known as "Kampfgruppe Müller," participated in the occupation of the Dodecanese Falands in November and December 1943 and other components becaue Sturmbrigade Rhodes. The division evacuated Crete in the summer of 1944 and then engaged in antipartisan warfare in Greece and Yugoslavia. It capitulated in Yugoslavia in May 1945.
