

23. Infanterie-Division (23d Infantry Division)

The 23. Infanterie-Division was formed in the autumn of 1935 in Potsdam by expansion of Infanterie-Regiment 9 of the old Reichswehr. In 1939 the division took part in the campaign in Poland and in 1940 in the western campaign. From June 1941 until June 1942 the division fought on the eastern front, central sector, where it suffered heavy losses. Although there are no records of the division available for the period June 22 to September 20, 1942, the situation maps of Heeresgruppe Süd and Lage West show that the division departed from Izheshkovo, Russia, on June 27, 1942, and arrived at Charleroi, Belgium, on July 1, 1942. It was transferred in August to north of Tourcoing, France. In September 1942 the 26. Panzer-Division was formed from the 26. Panzergrenadier-Brigade (Infanterie-Regiments 9 and 67 of the 23. Infanterie-Division). Another regiment of the division, Infanterie-Regiment 68, was transferred to Denmark in October 1942 to form the nucleus of a new 23. Infanterie-Division. In January 1943 the division was transferred from Denmark to Pskov. From January to May it

took part in the defense of the Staraya Russa, Novgorod, Chudovo, and Gatchina areas and from May to August in the Mga, Gatchina, and Novgorod areas. Although there are no records of the division available dated later than August 10, 1943, the situation maps of Lage Ost show that in September and October 1943 the division defended the Novgorod area and in November and December participated in the defensive battle at Nevel. From January through March 1944 it defended the Polotsk area and in April part of the division defended Tallin (Reval) and the main part the Ostrov area. It took part in position defense in the Pustoshka area from May through July and in the Madona area in August and September. The division participated in operations from October to early December on the Saare Island and the Sorve Peninsula and was transferred on December 9, 1944, from Ventspils to Danzig. From December 1944 to February 1945 the division was rehabilitated in the Mikolajki area and took part in operations from March through April 1945 in the Praust and Danzig areas.
