

24. Infanterie-Division (24th Infantry Division)

The 24. Infanterie-Division (1. Welle) was formed in 1935-36 during the expansion of the Army after the introduction of universal military service in March 1935. In September 1939 it participated in the campaign against Poland and in May 1940 in the western campaign. It was transferred to the southern sector of the eastern front in June 1941 and fought its way to Kremenchug, south to Krivoi Rog, and finally to the Crimea. In July 1942 it helped capture Sevastopol. The division was transferred to the northern sector south of Leningrad in August 1942, where it participated in operations along the Volkhov River between Chudovo and Volkhov and along the Moscow-

Leningrad railroad line between Lyuban and Kolpino. Although there are no records of the division available dated later than June 30, 1943, the situation maps of Lage Ost show that the division fought in the third battle at Lake Ladoga from July to September 1943 and in position defense in the Kolpino area until January 1944. Components of the division took part in the defensive battle at Nevel, October 21 to November 12, 1943. The division participated in defensive action from January to April 1944 in the Strugi Krasnye, Idritsa, and Pustoshka areas and in position defense in the Polotsk area from April to July, in the Madona area from August to October, and in the Auce (Autse) area from October 1944 to April 1945.
