The 26. Infanterie-Division was formed in 1935-36 during the expansion of the Army after the introduction of universal military service in March 1935. In May and June 1940 the division took part in the western campaign. Between December 1940 and May 1941 it was transferred to Lotzen, East Prussia, for preparations for the campaign against Russia. From June 1941 the division was employed in the central sector of the eastern front and participated in the battles on the Volga River between Rzhev and Kalinin in the fall and winter of 1941 and in the Orel area in the spring of 1942. The division suffered heavy losses south of Voronezh between the Don and Donets Rivers in the fall and winter of 1942, and in the Kursk offensive in the summer of 1943. Although no records of this

division dated later than July 13, 1943, except for two items dated August 5 and December 16-31, 1944, are available, situation maps of Lage Ost and West show that it participated in defensive engagements in the Sumy, Trubchevsk, and Roslavl areas from July to October 1943 and position defense in the Dubrovno area until February 1944. It moved northward in March to defend the Idritsa area and returned in April to defend the Gorki area. From May to July the division took part in position defense in the Kovel area and in August and September defended the Radom and Wierzbnik areas. In October 1944 it was transferred to the Trier area, and reorganized as a Volksgrenadier-Division. From December 1944 to January 1945 the division fought in the Ardennes counteroffensive in the Bastogne area.
