The 27. Panzer-Division was formed about August 29, 1942, in the Voronezh area from Panzer-Regiment 140 of the 22. Panzer-Division, which was variously designated Kampfgruppe Michalik

and Brigade 22. It participated in defensive operations in the area south of Voronezh and north of Voroshilovgrad until it was disbanded on February 9, 1943.
