33. Infanterie-Division (33d Infantry Division)

The 33. Infanterie-Division (1. Welle) was formed during expansion of the Army after introduction of universal military service in March 1935. It participated in the western campaign in May

1940. The division was reorganized as the 15. Panzer-Division on November 11, 1940, when it supplied Infanterie-Regiment 110 to the 112. Infanterie-Division and added Panzer-Regiment 8.
