The Seventh Army was activated on September 3, 1939. It participated in the campaign in the West in 1940 and remained in western France. During 1944 it was engaged in France and in the Ardennes counteroffensive. The 7th Army was disbanded on May 8, 1945. Commanders between 1939 and 1945 were Generals Friedrich Dollmann, Paul Hausser, Heinrich Eberbach, Erich Brandenberger, Hans Gustav Felber, and Hans von Obstfelder.
