## Korps Feldt (Corps Feldt)

In July 1944 General Kurt Feldt, Military Commander of Southwest France, was ordered to take his staff from south France, which had become a combat zone, and take command of a new corps to be named Corps Feldt. The corps was stationed on the "Westwall," and saw action from September to December 1944.
