

Generalkommando Schneckenburger (Corps Headquarters Schneckenburger)

This battle group with corps status was activated in 1944 by General Hans Gustav Felber, Military Commander in the Southeast. It had the task of holding the Danube Sector between the Morava and Tisza Rivers following the capitulation of Bulgaria, and was charged with the evacuation of female personnel and civilian employees. The Rumanians, former allies, were opposing this unit, as were Russian columns. Its commander was General Schneckenburger, who was killed in October 1944, after which the unit reverted to the command of the Commandant of Belgrade.
