

1. Skijäger-Division (1st Light Mountain Division)

The 1st Light Mountain Division was originally formed in October 1943 as the 1st Ski Brigade. The conversion to the 1st Light Mountain Division took place in the summer of 1944. It fought first in the central sector of the eastern front, and then, in September 1944, in the Vistula area. In October 1944 the Division was transferred to Slovakia, and in December 1944 it withdrew into southern Poland.

1. Leichte-Division (1st Light Infantry Division)

The 1st Light Infantry Division was formed at Wuppertal, Wehrkreis VI, in the period 1936-1937. It contained Panzer Battalion 65 and Mechanized Cavalry Regiment 4. In September 1939 it participated in the campaign in Poland.
